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PRODUCT REGISTRATION



CAUTION

Keep the monitor away from water sources or damp places, such as bathrooms, kitchens, basements and swimming pools.

Make to place the monitor on a flat surface. If the monitor falls down, it could lead to injury or damage to the device.

Store and use the monitor in a cool, dry and well-ventilated place, and keep it away from emission and heat sources.

Do not cover or block the vent hole in the rear casing, and do not use the product on a bed, sofa, blanket or similar surfaces.

The voltage range of the monitor's power supply is printed on the label on the rear casing. If you can't determine the voltage of your power outputs, please consult the distributor or local power company.

If the monitor will not be used for a long period, please cut off the power supply to avoid electric shock in rainy days or damage due to abnormal supply voltage.

Please use a plug with a reliable ground socket, do not overload the socket, or it may cause fire or electric shock.

Do not put foreign materials inside of the monitor, as they may cause short circuits which could result in a fire or electric shock.

Do not disassemble or repair this product yourself to avoid electric shock. If malfunctions occur, please contact the after-sales service directly.

Do not pull or twist the power cable with force.

There is a polarizer layer (not a protective film) on the surface of the screen. Do not peel it off, or the product may be damaged and the warranty will be void.



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PACKAGE CONTENTS

Please check that the package for the monitor contains every part. If any part is lost, please contact the distributor.

The color and shape of the parts may vary with models. Figures in this User Manual are for reference only.

Wires supplied may vary depending on the purchased products. Figures in this User Manual are for reference only.



STAND INSTALLATION

Steps:

01. Put the base into the hole of the rear shell at a tilt along the arrow direction, as shown in Figure 1.

02. Insert the base into the support and lock two M4*16 screws, as shown in Figure 2.

03. Rotate the whole base clockwise downward and put it in, as shown in Figure 2 and 3.



To remove the entire base, perform the following steps.

01. Unscrew the two M4*16 screws on the base and pull it out in the arrow direction, as show in Figure 4.

02. Push the slider near the VESA cover of the base upward, as shown in Figure 5.

03. Rotate the whole base counterclockwise upward, as shown in Figure 5.

04. Tilt the base along the arrow direction and take it out, as shown in Figure 6.



Note:

Some of the contents in this manual may differs lightly from the final product, and the later shall be referred to.

Insert the stand plate onto the opening on the back of the monitor. It should click into place. Make sure the stand is securely attached to the back of the monitor before removing the monitor from the remaining foam and setting it up on a firm, level table or desk.



Note:

The stand can be easily detached from the monitor by pressing the button near the stand cover. Make sure the monitor is laid on a flat surface before removing the stem.

MOUNT INSTALLATION

1. Open the box, take the product out with the foam still attached, and gently place it on a desktop or table. Remove the extra parts and the foam covering the back of the monitor. If the monitor has a stand attached to it already, remove the stand.



2. When hanging the product, do not press on the screen with your hand to avoid damaging the screen.



Notes:

- To prevent the monitor from failing, please install it firmly and in a safe place.

- Do not place or hang any object on the mount, and don't hang it at a height of over 2 meters.

EXPLANATION OF INDICATORS Indicator:

When the display is working normally, the blue indicator light is on; When it is in the energy saving state, the indicator light blinks with red color; When the signals are sent again in the energy saving state, the machine will return to normal work; After the display is turned off, the indicator light is off. As the display is still powered under the shut down state, for the sake of safety, the power cord should be unplugged when the display is notused.

SAFETY PROTECTION:

When the video signals of PC exceeds the frequency range of the display, the horizontal and field synchronizing signals will be shut down to protect the display. Then, you have to set the PC output frequency to an acceptable range so as to make the display work normally.
